Dear

In consideration of Your acceptance of this letter, [*Blank Title Insurance Company*] (the “Company”), agrees to indemnify You for actual loss of Funds incurred by You in connection with the closing of the Real Estate Transaction conducted by the Issuing Agent or Approved Attorney on or after the Date of this letter, subject to the Requirements and Conditions and Exclusions set forth below:

REQUIREMENTS

1. The Company issues or is contractually obligated to issue a Policy for Your protection in connection with the Real Estate Transaction;
2. You are to be a:
 - a. lender secured by the Insured Mortgage on the Title to the Land; or
 - b. purchaser or lessee of the Title to the Land;
3. The aggregate of all Funds You transmit to the Issuing Agent or Approved Attorney for the Real Estate Transaction does not exceed \$_____; and
4. Your loss is solely caused by:
 - a. a failure of the Issuing Agent or Approved Attorney to comply with Your written closing instructions that relate to:
 - i. (a). the disbursement of Funds necessary to establish the status of the Title to the Land; or
 - (b). the validity, enforceability, or priority of the lien of the Insured Mortgage; or
 - ii. obtaining any document, specifically required by You, but only to the extent that the failure to obtain the document adversely affects the status of the Title to the Land or the validity, enforceability, or priority of the lien of the Insured Mortgage on the Title to the Land; or



- 54 b. fraud, theft, dishonesty, or misappropriation by the Issuing Agent or Approved Attorney in
55 handling Your Funds or documents in connection with the closing, but only to the extent that
56 the fraud, theft, dishonesty, or misappropriation adversely affects the status of the Title to the
57 Land or the validity, enforceability, or priority of the lien of the Insured Mortgage on the Title to
58 the Land.

60 CONDITIONS AND EXCLUSIONS

- 63 1. Your transmittal of Funds or documents to the Issuing Agent or Approved Attorney for the Real Estate
64 Transaction constitutes Your acceptance of this letter.
- 65
- 66 2. For purposes of this letter:
- 67 a. "Commitment" means the Company's written contractual agreement to issue the Policy.
- 68 b. "Funds" means the money received by the Issuing Agent or Approved Attorney for the Real
69 Estate Transaction.
- 70 c. "Policy" means the contract or contracts of title insurance, each in a form adopted by the
71 American Land Title Association, issued or to be issued by the Company in connection with
72 the closing of the Real Estate Transaction.
- 73 d. "You" or "Your" means:
- 74 i. the Addressee of this letter;
- 75 ii. the borrower, if the Land is improved solely by a one-to-four family residence; and
- 76 iii. subject to all rights and defenses relating to a claim under this letter that the Company
77 would have against the Addressee,
- 78 (a). the assignee of the Insured Mortgage, provided such assignment was for value
79 and the assignee was, at the time of the assignment, without Knowledge of facts
80 that reveal a claim under this letter; and
- 81 (b). the warehouse lender in connection with the Insured Mortgage.
- 82 e. "Indebtedness," "Insured Mortgage," "Knowledge" or "Known," "Land," and "Title" have the
83 same meaning given them in the American Land Title Association Loan Policy.
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- 85 3. The Company is not liable under this letter for any loss arising from any:
- 86 a. failure of the Issuing Agent or Approved Attorney to comply with Your closing instructions that
87 require title insurance protection in connection with the Real Estate Transaction inconsistent
88 with that set forth in the Commitment. Your written closing instructions received and accepted
89 by the Issuing Agent or Approved Attorney after issuing the Commitment that require the
90 removal, where allowed by state law, rule, or regulation, of specific Schedule B Exceptions
91 from Coverage or compliance with the requirements contained in the Commitment will not be
92 deemed to require inconsistent title insurance protection;
- 93 b. loss or impairment of Funds in the course of collection or while on deposit with a bank due to
94 bank failure, insolvency, or suspension, except loss or impairment resulting from failure of the
95 Issuing Agent or Approved Attorney to comply with Your written closing instructions to deposit
96 Your Funds in a bank that You designated by name;
- 97 c. constitutional or statutory lien or claim of lien that arises from services, labor, materials, or
98 equipment, if any Funds are to be used for the purpose of construction, alteration, or
99 renovation. Condition and Exclusion 3.c. does not modify or limit Your coverage, if any, as to
100 any lien for services, labor, materials, or equipment in the Policy;
- 101 d. defect, lien, encumbrance, adverse claim, or other matter in connection with the Real Estate
102 Transaction. Condition and Exclusion 3.d. does not modify or limit Your coverage in the Policy;
- 103 e. fraud, theft, dishonesty, misappropriation, or negligence by You or by Your employee, agent,
104 attorney, or broker;
- 105 f. fraud, theft, dishonesty, or misappropriation by anyone other than the Company, Issuing Agent,
106 or Approved Attorney;

- 107 g. settlement or release of any claim by You without the Company's written consent;
108 h. matters created, suffered, assumed, agreed to, or Known by You;
109 i. failure of the Issuing Agent or Approved Attorney to determine the validity, enforceability, or the
110 effectiveness of a document required by Your closing instructions. Condition and Exclusion 3.i.
111 does not modify or limit Your coverage in the Policy;
112 j. Any law regulating trade, lending, credit, sale, and debt collection practices involving
113 consumers; any consumer financial law; or any other law relating to truth-in-lending, predatory
114 lending, or a borrower's ability to repay a loan, including any failure of the Issuing Agent or
115 Approved Attorney to comply with Your closing instructions relating to those laws;
116 k. federal or state laws establishing the standards or requirements for asset-backed securitization
117 including, but not limited to, exemption from credit risk retention, including any failure of the
118 Issuing Agent or Approved Attorney to comply with Your closing instructions relating to those
119 laws;
120 l. periodic disbursement of Funds to pay for construction, alteration, or renovation on the Land;
121 m. Issuing Agent or Approved Attorney acting in the capacity of a qualified intermediary or
122 facilitator for tax deferred exchange transactions as provided in Section 1031 of the Internal
123 Revenue Code; or
124 n. wire fraud, mail fraud, telephone fraud, facsimile fraud, unauthorized access to a computer,
125 network, email, or document production system, business email compromise, identity theft, or
126 diversion of Funds to a person or account not entitled to receive the Funds. Condition and
127 Exclusion 3.n. does not modify or limit:
128 i. Your coverage in the Policy; or
129 ii. indemnification in this letter for Your loss solely caused by fraud, theft, dishonesty, or
130 misappropriation by the Issuing Agent or Approved Attorney in handling Your Funds or
131 documents in connection with the closing, but only to the extent that the fraud, theft,
132 dishonesty, or misappropriation adversely affects the status of the Title to the Land or
133 the validity, enforceability, or priority of the lien of the Insured Mortgage on the Title to
134 the Land.
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136 4. If the closing is to be conducted by an Approved Attorney, a Commitment in connection with the Real
137 Estate Transaction must have been received by You prior to the transmittal of Your final closing
138 instructions to the Approved Attorney.
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140 5. When the Company indemnifies You pursuant to this letter, it is subrogated to all rights and remedies
141 You have against any person, entity, or property had You not been indemnified. The Company's
142 liability for indemnification is reduced to the extent that You have impaired the value of this
143 subrogation right.
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145 6. The Company's liability for loss under this letter does not exceed the least of:
146 a. the amount of Your Funds;
147 b. the Company's liability under the Policy at the time written notice of a claim is made under this
148 letter;
149 c. the value of the lien of the Insured Mortgage;
150 d. the value of the Title to the Land insured or to be insured under the Policy at the time written
151 notice of a claim is made under this letter; or
152 e. the amount stated in Requirement 3.
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154 7. The Company is liable only to the owner of the Indebtedness at the time that payment is made.
155 Condition and Exclusion 7 does not apply to a purchaser, borrower, or lessee.
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157 8. Payment to You or to the owner of the Indebtedness under either the Policy or from any other source
158 reduces liability under this letter by the same amount. Payment in accordance with the terms of this
159 letter constitutes a payment pursuant to the Conditions of the Policy.

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9. The Issuing Agent is the Company's agent only for the limited purpose of issuing policies. Neither the Issuing Agent nor the Approved Attorney is the Company's agent for the purpose of providing closing or settlement services. The Company's liability for Your loss arising from closing or settlement services is strictly limited to the contractual protection expressly provided in this letter. The Company is not liable for loss resulting from the fraud, theft, dishonesty, misappropriation, or negligence of any party to the Real Estate Transaction, the lack of creditworthiness of any borrower connected with the Real Estate Transaction, or the failure of any collateral to adequately secure a loan connected with the Real Estate Transaction.
 10. The Company is not liable for a loss if the written notice of a claim is not received by the Company within one year from the date of the transmittal of Funds. The condition that the Company must be provided with written notice under Condition and Exclusion 10 will not be excused by lack of prejudice to the Company.
 11. You must promptly send written notice of a claim under this letter to the Company at its principal office at _____. If the Company is prejudiced by Your failure to provide prompt notice, the Company's liability to You under this letter is reduced to the extent of the prejudice.
 12. When requested by the Company, You, at the Company's expense, must:
 - a. give the Company all reasonable aid in:
 - i. securing evidence, obtaining witnesses, prosecuting or defending any action or proceeding, or effecting any settlement; and
 - ii. any other lawful act that in the opinion of the Company may be necessary or desirable to enable the Company's investigation and determination of its liability under this letter;
 - b. deliver to the Company all records, in whatever medium maintained, that pertain to the Real Estate Transaction or any claim under this letter; and
 - c. submit to examination under oath by any authorized representative of the Company with respect to any such records, the Real Estate Transaction, any claim under this letter or any other matter reasonably deemed relevant by the Company.
 13. The Company is not liable under this letter if:
 - a. the Real Estate Transaction has not closed within one year from the Date of this letter; or
 - b. at any time after the Date of this letter, but before the Real Estate Transaction closes, the Company provides written notice of termination of this letter to the Addressee at the address set forth above.
 14. The protection of this letter extends only to real estate in [State], and any court or arbitrator must apply the law of that state to interpret and enforce the terms of this letter. The court or arbitrator must not apply conflicts of law principles to determine the applicable law. Any litigation or other proceeding under this letter must be filed only in a state or federal court within the United States of America or its territories having jurisdiction.
 15. There is no right for any claim under this letter to be arbitrated or litigated on a class action basis.
 - [16. Either the Company or You may demand that any claim arising under this letter be submitted to arbitration pursuant to the Title Insurance Arbitration Rules of the American Land Title Association, unless You have a Policy for the Real Estate Transaction with an Amount of Insurance greater than \$2,000,000. If You have a Policy for the Real Estate Transaction with an Amount of Insurance greater than \$2,000,000, a claim arising under this letter may be submitted to arbitration only when agreed to by both the Company and You. [If the Real Estate Transaction solely involves a one-to-four family residence and You are the purchaser or borrower, the Company will pay the costs of arbitration.]]

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This letter supersedes and cancels any previous letter or similar agreement for closing protection that applies to the Real Estate Transaction and may not be modified by the Issuing Agent or Approved Attorney.
